FPS TO THE RESCUE

We may not be fighting fires, but we're helping the firefighters! This past month we have had two opportunities to give our wildland firefighters some peace of mind. The first time was a call from a group of firefighters from Montana in our area temporarily. They found a little, emaciated kitten out in the middle of nowhere. They needed someone to take care of the kitten, who they named Cortez, for one week while they finished their assignment here and then headed home. While we don't do pet sitting, we were able to connect them with one of our dedicated members who gladly took the little guy in. After a trip to the vet to treat his upper respiratory infection and some special food, paid for by the firefighting team, he started perking up and gaining weight. At the end of the week he was a lively little kid and headed north to live with one of the team members. What a lucky kitten!

Our second opportunity to help was when a local firefighter called and said that her momma barn cat had collapsed and she didn't know what to do about her EIGHT kittens. They were about six weeks old and the caretaker didn't want to just leave them while she went to work three or four days a week in Pagosa Springs, where she is currently stationed. Fortunately, we had a foster home available and they moved in. The caretaker brought the momma inside and took her to the vet, who cleaned up a large abscess that burst the night after we took the kittens. The mom is doing fine now. And so are the kittens. They are cute, cute, cute, and have turned into friendly, bouncy kids.
