What a difference a year makes. Our May 2024 newsletter discussed what would happen if For Pets' Sake disbanded. What would it mean for the animals and their people in our community? The future is looking much brighter for FPS today. We've added two new board members, with a possible third one in the wings. A generous bequest from a former member has provided some relief from our day-to-day financial worries. Several programs have been adjusted due to fewer vets in the area, but all programs are going strong thanks to our board members and YOUR generous contributions.

These uncertain financial times make FPS even more important. WE don't want people to delay spaying or neutering their animals because they can't afford it. WE don't want animals to suffer unnecessarily because their owners cannot afford their medical care. WE don't want people to have to decide between feeding themselves or their animals.

As For Pets' Sake enters its 41st year, the support of our members is more important than ever. Thanks to grants from the LOR Foundation, Animal Assistance Foundation, Colorado Pet Overpopulation Fund, and Friends of the Aspen Animal Shelter, and YOUR generous donations, FPS works hard helping local dogs and cats. We reduce animal suffering by providing medical assistance to animals in need. Spay/Neuter assistance has always been the core of FPS, and within the past 41 years, over 10,000 local pets have been spayed or neutered. Our pet food program continues to nourish needy local pets, and the Feral Cat Project, now in its 17th year, has fixed over 6,518 cats. FPS has rescued thousands of cats, dogs, kittens, and puppies and placed them in their forever homes. WE have accomplished so much together, and we do it with a 100% volunteer staff and no physical location.
