#### Celebrate National Pet Wellness Month

In October, we think of ghosts, jack-o'-lanterns, and the For Pets' Sake Halloween Bake Sale. But it's also National Pet Wellness Month, sponsored by the American Veterinary Medical Association (AVMA) since 2004, to educate pet owners about the pet aging process, the importance of preventive care, and the need to develop positive lifestyle choices for dogs and cats.

In 1761, Frenchman Claude Bourgelat established the first veterinary school. But it wasn't until the mid-1900s that pets began to be seen as family members rather than working animals. This change significantly impacted how pets were cared for and led to advancements in vet care, disease prevention, and treatment options. The AVMA encourages pet owners to address these key areas of pet wellness:



- Regular vet visits for vaccines and screenings
- Routine dental care to prevent gum disease
- A balanced, age-appropriate diet
- Regular activity for physical and mental health
- Protection from fleas, ticks, and parasites
- Updated vaccinations and microchipping
- A safe and healthy home environment
- New toys to stimulate their minds

According to the AVMA, the most common pet nutritional problem is obesity. If your pet is over-

weight, work with your veterinarian to determine the best age-appropriate diet. FPS's number one health care assistance request is for dental care. FPS will provide some help through our grant from the Animal Assistance Foundation, so please remember FPS is here to help when needed.

While you are celebrating Halloween by creating that perfect costume or carving the scariest jack-o'-lantern, remember to give extra love and attention to your best friend(s).
