June is Membership Month!

As For Pets' Sake enters its 40th year, the support of our members is more critical than ever. With the support of grants from the Animal Assistance Foundation, the Colorado Pet Overpopulation Fund, the Friends of the Aspen Animal Shelter, and YOUR generous donations, FPS works hard right here in southwestern Colorado helping local dogs and cats. And we do it all with 100% volunteer staff and no physical location.

For Pets' Sake helps in so many ways.

We reduce animal suffering by providing medical assistance to animals in need. At an average of 135 medical assists per year, 5,400 animals have been able to live healthier, happier lives in the last 40 years. Often the requests are for large amounts, \$1500 to \$2500, and although the FPS maximum is \$250, where would these animals turn if we were NOT there to help?

Spay/Neuter assistance has always been the core of For Pets' Sake, and within the past 40 years, over 10,000 pets have been spayed or neutered. Where else would these animals go?

Our pet food program distributed over 24,500 pounds of food in 2022 and has been helping feed pets for most of our 40 years. How many animals would not be properly fed without our help?

Our Feral Cat program, now in its fifteenth year, will have fixed over 6,000 cats by the end of 2023. What would be the feral cat situation here if we had not started the Feral Cat Project?

Over the years, For Pets' Sake has also rescued thousands of cats and dogs, kittens and puppies, and placed them in their forever homes. Where would they be without FPS help?

For Pets' Sake always puts helping animals first, with well over 90% of our funds going to directly helping dogs and cats.

We are an all-volunteer organization, and plan to stay that way, but just like everyone else right now, we are feeling a financial crunch. Prices are higher and needs are greater. As the needs of the community grow, so do our financial needs. That is why YOUR support during this membership drive is so important. If For Pets' Sake is to continue to serve the dogs and cats of our community, your increased financial support is critically important.

As we enter our 40th year, the need is also greater than ever for volunteers. Help is needed at events, and especially as working Board members. Our current hard-working Board members are getting older. Programs may need to be cut if new people do not step up to help. Where will people go with animals in medical need? To get their animals spayed/neutered? To find food for hungry pets? Or to receive assistance with feral cat colonies? During this membership drive, please give generously of your money and your time. The animals need YOU. For Pets' Sake needs YOU. Please help For Pets' Sake keep the momentum going for the next 40 years.



DUMPED AT THE DUMP


In mid March, employees at the Montezuma County Landfill noticed a pretty little black and tan dog walking around all the vehicles like she was looking for her people. They called the shelter, and it seemed nobody was looking for this sweet girl. In all likelihood, some heartless person dumped this petite little sweetie like garbage. Thankfully the staff had been feeding and watering her and bringing her in at night. They named her Sugar. They already have a shop cat who was not at all pleased with the new addition, so they determined in order to keep the peace, Sugar could not stay, even though she was a lovely little shop dog, perfectly well behaved and content to just hang around the office and greet everyone that came in. They contacted FPS to see if we could help find her a good home.

We went out to meet her and she was just adorable. She seemed young and we were worried that she may go into heat anytime or may already be pregnant. The staff agreed to keep her indoors and care for her until we could find an adopter or rescue partner. We got busy scheduling appointments to get her vaccinated and spayed. Right after we arranged those appointments, a gentleman who frequents the landfill met her and fell in love. He already had a young neutered male dog and we arranged a meeting to see if they would get along, which they definitely did! He agreed to foster Sugar until we could get her vetting completed and formalize the adoption. A couple of weeks later, we made the adoption official and she was renamed Mesa. She now lives on beautiful acreage up near Summit Lake and has two people who adore her and a doggy brother to share adventures with. We're so happy that we could find her a loving home.

One more update on the Dove Creek Colony...

Missy's four kittens are growing up! They turned into HEALTHY happy youngsters and have now gone to a foster home in Glenwood Springs with their mom. But before they could go, we knew that we had to send a healthy mom, too. Missy went to the veterinarian to have a broken canine removed - but after a more thorough exam and xrays, it turned out she had serious resorptive lesions on all of her teeth, just like Harrison. Some of her teeth were so thin that they didn't even show up on the x-rays. So, For Pets' Sake unexpectedly ended up with an \$1100+ dental bill for Missy to remove all of her teeth just three days before she left. But boy, even with her mouth hurting from the surgery, she seemed calmer and more interested in her wet food. We did good. . . but we could use some help paying for this unexpectedly large expense to our FINN (Fosters In Need Now) Fund. The FINN Fund is our cushion to help take care of large expenses for our fosters. We will always take care of these animals in need, but if we have money in the FINN Fund, then we don't have to take it away from other programs.
